Under the agreement, HueMetrix will initially perform analytical work at its facility in Raleigh, North Carolina and then eventually on-site at Interface Fabrics.

“We are committed to understanding and achieving sustainability in all of its elements,” said Lee Woodard, Senior Vice President of Quality for Interface Fabrics. “These projects will allow us to better understand the dye exhaustion characteristics of different types of new and recycled substrates to produce better and more consistent product quality while further advancing our financial and environmental sustainability goals consistent with our Seven Fronts.”
